## A Study of 1 Corinthians 1

### **QUESTIONS FOR FURTHER THOUGHT, STUDY, & REFLECTION**

#### *[SECTION 1] 1 Corinthians 1.1-9*

Q: Paul specifies two points of “calling” in this passage – *called to be saints* (set apart ones, holy) and *called into fellowship with Jesus*. How do you interpret these callings? How are they related? How would they have been significant in early Corinth and how are they significant for you/us now?

Q: As think about this passage, would you say that God influences or impacts all aspects of your life? Are there areas where you look to other sources for enrichment? Or what does it mean for us to be enriched in Christ in every way?

*[SECTION 2] 1 Corinthians 1.10-17*

Q: Take a moment to reflect on what divided the Corinthian church? Why do you think these type of divisions happen?

Q: What kind of divisions do we create today? What kind of results come from these divisions?

Q: Paul seems to say that 'eloquent wisdom' can take away from the power of the cross. Does that make sense to you? In what way might that happen? What are some ways we distract and detract from the power of the cross?
