1 CORINTHIANS 1.18-25

Q: In what way does God's power found in Jesus & the cross seem like foolishness or weakness?

Q: Based on your response above, how does this (Or Does this) make "Christ crucified" a stumbling block?

1 CORINTHIANS 1.26-31

Q: Do you agree that our desire to be 'somebody' can create division? If so, in what ways?

Q: How does this passage sit with you? Does it create any tension in you?

1 CORINTHIANS 2.1-13

Q: Paul's words are not anti-government or about rebellion. But they are about challenging the wisdom of this world. What might that look like these days?

Q: Paul's 'proclamation' was with a demonstration of the Spirit & of power, was seen in his living. Looking at yourself, in what way does the Spirit empower your life? In what ways do you pray/hope the Spirit would empower your life?
