

## Summer Student Drop-in Worker Job Description

Spring/Summer 2022

### Who is One88?

One88 Community Church is located at 188 Princess Street, at the northern edge of the Winnipeg Exchange District. We seek to show God's love to others, proclaim the hope found in Christ, and help each other discover purpose in life. The church runs a Drop-in Monday to Friday for vulnerable people in downtown Winnipeg. It's a space for people experiencing homelessness, struggling with addictions, caught in systemic cycles of poverty, dealing with mental health issues, etc.. The Drop-in is open to everyone and provides a safe caring space for approximately 50-60 people each day. The Drop-in offers the following services:

- Public washroom & Public phone
- Shower and/or hygiene supplies
- Free Laundry service
- Free coffee/tea & occasional meals/snacks



### SUMMER JOB OPPORTUNITY

We are seeking two (2) Summer Student Drop-in Workers to help care for and work with people who frequent the One88 Drop-in. We have the flexibility for these to be full or part-time positions. The task is to help manage and provide services as well as build value and dignity into vulnerable people in downtown Winnipeg. These positions are funded in cooperation with the Province of Manitoba's Green Team Program. **Applicants must be between the ages of 18 and 29. Positions run from mid-May to end of August 2022.**

#### Specific tasks related to Summer Student Drop-in employees:

- **Build Relationships** (taking time to get to know people & hear their stories)
- **Cleaning** (wiping tables, high touch points, windows, floors & bathrooms)
- **Laundry** (receiving bags when people drop off, retrieving bags for pick-up, & doing laundry throughout the day)
- **Showers** (managing the shower list, handing out supplies, & cleaning the shower)
- **Hygiene supplies** (handing out supplies, receiving donations, & organizing supplies)
- **Greeting/Check-in** (handing out PPE, directing people to services)
- **Summer Community BBQs** (assist in coordination & provide children's programming)

All Summer Workers are supervised by the Community Drop-in Coordinator and the Community Life Chaplain. Training related to the Drop-in and specific to working in the Winnipeg downtown environment will be provided at start of employment.
